The **Forest Stewards Guild** invites interested individuals to apply for a fall forestry technician position on a small timber marking crew! Based out of the **Mt. Taylor Ranger District in Grants, NM**, this position focuses on forestry and ecological restoration.

October 2 - November 17 | 40 hours/week | \$17.76 per hour

Applicants must be able to work up to 10 hours and hike 5+ miles/day while carrying 15 lbs.

WHAT THE JOB ENTAILS

Successful applicants will learn the basics of forestry, including how and why land managers treat the forest in the way they do.

Learn how to:

- Select the best trees for restoration,
- Follow forest health guidelines to prepare areas for thinning (tree cutting),
- Take basic forestry measurements such as tree diameter, height, and basal area,
- Mark trees for harvest or retention following ecological guidelines

This position is under the employ of the Forest Stewards Guild with supervision by timber staff on the Mt. Taylor Ranger district. All work is in support of the Zuni Mountains Collaborative Forest Landscape Restoration Program (CFLRP).
